SECTION II: Discussion Items

- A. Kara Welch, Woodland’s Library Media Technology Specialist shared the work of the District in increasing technology. She shared the 1:1 device initiative for grades 3-12. For the lower levels, different models are being tried out. One kindergarten and two first grade classrooms are piloting the use of IPADS. The Technology Committee is brainstorming ways to use technology to support grade level curriculum. It was shared how Miss Duquette’s class took pictures of math in the classroom and went outside to take pictures to demonstrate the season Fall. Grade 2 has selected to increase access to laptops in the classroom to continue building keyboarding skills and to research.
